Commission to host a technical conference for discussion of revisions to W.S. 37-2-128 and 37-2-131(a) recently recommended by the Commission to the Joint Minerals, Business, and Economic Development Committee of the Wyoming Legislature. The recommendation included:

- a. Name change to reflect the new federal PIPES Act 2006 which replaces the federal NGPSA of 1968;
- b. Updated penalties to coincide with the federal penalty levels;
- c. Deletion of rural gathering line definition at the end of W.S. § 37-2-131(a) which has been abolished at the federal level; and,
- d. Clarification that the United States Secretary of Transportation cannot delegate unknown authority to the State of Wyoming without State approval.

These revisions are believed necessary to reflect the supplanting of the federal Natural Gas Pipeline Safety Act of 1968 by the Pipeline Inspection, Protection, Enforcement, and Safety Act of 2006.
