The Commission's newly revised Rules became effective on March 21, 2016. Accordingly, this technical conference has been set to discuss implementation and engage in a collaborative effort to ensure that telecommunications company price schedules on file are in compliance with the new Rules. Staff believes the following information may be useful, and encourages each company to take this opportunity to review and update all price schedules currently on file with the Commission.

Deadline:

- All companies have until **September 30, 2016**, to bring price schedules into compliance with the Commission's Rules.

General Tips:

- As some revisions will be necessary, this is an opportunity to carefully review your price schedules and make any required and clarifying revisions. See generally Commission Rules Chapter 4, Section 17.
- Please ensure if your company is providing a URL for its price schedules to be placed on DMS, that the link leads directly to the newest Wyoming price schedules and that the link listed on the DMS system actually works. When providing the URL to the Commission please include the Company name, the Company's ID ex. 70001, the Company's price schedule URL, and the effective date.

General Price Schedule Changes:

- PSC Staff have identified the following general changes/corrections that most telecommunications companies will need to address:
 - The "Symbols" Price Schedule will need to be changed. For example, "C" will now stand for **Cancel**, not **Change** and "D" will for **Decrease** now, not **Discontinued**, etc. See Rules Chapter 4, Section 17(a)(x);

- Rules Chapter 4, Section 11 - Discontinuation of telecommunications services to customers has been revised. Please review this Rule and make any necessary conforming changes to price schedules;
- In discussing the Wyoming Universal Service Fund (WUSF), please change any reference to the 130% statewide average price, to the \$30 imputed price benchmark. See Rules Chapter 5 and W.S. § 37-15-501.
- Please change any specific reference to a Commission Rule using the previous section numbering system to reference the new Rule Chapter/Section;
- Please remove any reference to State matching Telephone Assistance Program (TAP) discounts, since it has been statutorily repealed.
- Please note that interest on deposits held should be equal to or less than currently applicable rates as set forth by the Commission. See Rules Chapter 4, Section 9(g)
- Please generally review and remove any references to Commission Rules that no longer exist such as the previously discussed TAP fund.
- Please ensure that company price schedules accurately describe all of the exchanges in which service in Wyoming is offered, and what the rate is in each exchange;
- If the company's price schedule includes a provision forbidding resale, please consider whether this language is inconsistent with the resale obligation of all local exchange companies pursuant to 47 U.S.C. § 251(b) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996.
- As applicable, exchange area boundary maps for each exchange should be included in the price schedule.
- All maps previously provided to the Commission should be in compliance with any relevant Orders and updated if necessary.
- Please review the company's documents found online in DMS to ensure the online copy matches what the Company has as the approved price schedule, and correct any discrepancies;
- Please ensure that each price schedule has up-to-date local rate sheets that are properly authorized and numbered;
- Please carefully ensure that NOTHING new is included in the price schedule that is not part of the Commission's Rules revision, or that has not already been previously approved by the Commission. Care should be taken to not include a new substantive provision that was not already approved;

- Please carefully review and ensure any charges or fees the company normally levies on intrastate service, such as a reconnection charge, has an associated authorized fee in the price schedule.
