Notice of Intent to Adopt Rules and Regulations

Docket No. 90000-102-XO-08 (Record No. 11687) The Wyoming Public Service Commission (Commission) intends to amend Chapter V, Section 500 of its Procedural Rules and Special Regulations. Specifically, the amendment would revise subsection (j), subsection (p)

and create a new subsection (r) within Section 500. The amended rule is proposed for adoption pursuant to the rule making authority of the Commission and W.S. § 37-15-401.

The primary reason for the proposed amendment is to provide telecommunications companies designated as Eligible Telecommunications Carriers a process to propose diversion of some federal Universal Service Fund support from customer bill credits to specific construction projects or equipment upgrades, while subsidizing the costs of such authorized projects or upgrades through an increase in the Wyoming Universal Service Fund assessment. Such diversions would be subject to Commission approval under the proposed amended Section 500. This amendment to Section 500 was proposed by Qwest Corporation (Qwest) to facilitate telecommunications service quality improvements, including implementation of a capital expenditure proposal by Qwest in Docket No. 90000-96-XI-07, an investigation into the quality of telecommunications services in the Lander-Riverton Wind River Indian Reservation area.
