The Wyoming Public Service Commission (Commission) hereby gives public notice in accordance with WYO. STAT. § 16-3-103 (1977 as amended) of its intent to adopt one (1) revised rule, four (4) original rules, and five (5) original forms associated with the four (4) proposed original rules. The proposed revised and original rules will be adopted pursuant to the rulemaking authority of the Commission.

The following rules are proposed or are proposed to be amended: Rule 238. Interruption of Service; Rule 325. Electric Utility Service Interruption Reporting; Rule 420. Gas Utility Service Interruption Reporting; Rule 616. Water Utility Service Interruption Reporting; Rule 252. Reporting of Damage by Third Parties; and Rule 901. Forms., subsections (k), (l), (m), (n) and (o). These rules are proposed in order to provide guidance to public utilities as to their duty to report service interruptions and to report damage to facilities by third parties.

While the Commission has a rule governing the reporting of service interruptions (Rule 238), it has become necessary to amend that rule and add rules to specify exactly how each type of public utility is to report service interruptions. The Commission has not previously enacted a rule or rules governing the reporting of damage to utility facilities by third parties. All forms associated with the proposed rules are original and have not previously been in effect.

The Commission welcomes all comments and suggestions on these revised and original rules and regulations. Written comments must be received by the Commission no later than the close of business on January 5, 2009. Copies of the proposed rules and regulations are available at the Commission's offices in Cheyenne, upon written request, or by accessing the Commission's web site at <http://psc.state.wy.us>.
