2. The Wyoming Public Service Commission (Commission) hereby gives public notice in accordance with W.S. §§ 16-3-101, *et seq.*, 37-2-204 and 37-15-401(a)(iii), (1977 as amended), of its intent to revise Rules in Chapter 1 of its Rules and Regulations.
3. The Commission intends to initiate a rulemaking to revise Chapter 1 of the Commission's Rule 104: Filing of Applications, Other Documents and Communications, Amendments and Determinations of Time, Chapter 1. The Commission proposes revisions to Rule 104 which will provide members of the public, public utilities and telecommunications companies with guidance concerning the Commission's electronic filing procedures and to clarify general document filing requirements. The Commission has implemented an electronic filing system, accessible by all utilities and telecommunications companies, to reduce regulatory burdens and improve administrative efficiency.
4. The Commission welcomes all comments and suggestions on these proposed revised Rules. Written comments must be received by the Commission no later than the close of business on June 13, 2011. Copies of the proposed Rules are available at the Commission's offices in Cheyenne, upon written request, or by accessing the Commission's web site at <http://psc.state.wy.us>.
5. Any person may advocate that the Commission not adopt the proposed revised Rules and also request the Commission to state its reasons for overruling the considerations asserted against the adoption of these revised Rules. Requests for a Commission response must be made prior to, or within thirty (30) days after, adoption of the proposed revisions to the Rules, and be addressed to Victoria Hansen, Assistant Secretary, Public Service Commission, 2515 Warren Avenue, Suite 300, Cheyenne, Wyoming, 82002.
