

PUBLIC NOTICE

Pursuant to the Wyoming Administrative Procedure Act and the Wyoming Public Service Commission's (Commission) Procedural Rules and Special Regulations, notice is hereby given of the Application of Lower Valley Energy, Inc. (Lower Valley), for approval of its continuity of service and discontinuation of service tariff.

Lower Valley is a public utility as defined in Wyo. Stat. § 37-1-101(a)(vi)(C), subject to the Commission's jurisdiction pursuant to Wyo. Stat. § 37-2-112.

On April 16, 2018, Lower Valley filed its Application requesting authority to amend its continuity of service and discontinuation of service tariff to allow Lower Valley to discontinue service without notice for emergency repairs, unavoidable shortage or interruptions in its source of power supply without liability for damages for power interruptions or failure of service in those instances.

This is not a complete description of the Application. Interested persons may inspect the Application at Lower Valley's Wyoming business office and at the Commission's offices in Cheyenne, Wyoming, during regular business hours.

Anyone desiring to file a public comment, statement, intervention petition, protest or request for a public hearing in this matter must so file with the Commission in writing on or before May 18, 2018. Any intervention request filed with the Commission shall set forth the grounds of the proposed intervention or request for hearing as well as the position and the interest of the petitioner in this proceeding.
