

PUBLIC NOTICE

Pursuant to the Wyoming Administrative Procedure Act and the Wyoming Public Service Commission's (Commission) Rules, notice is hereby given that a public hearing is scheduled regarding the joint complaint filing by EverPower Wind Holdings, Inc. (EverPower); Pryor Caves Wind Project LLC; MUD Springs Wind Project LLC; and Horse Thief Wind Project LLC against Rocky Mountain Power (RMP or the Company) and PacifiCorp regarding the avoided cost pricing for the Bowler Flats Wind Qualifying Facilities Power Purchase Agreements. **The public hearing is set to commence on Monday, December 11, 2017, at 9:00 a.m., in the Commission's hearing room located at 2515 Warren Avenue, Suite 300, in Cheyenne, Wyoming.**

RMP is a public utility as defined in Wyo. Stat. § 37-1-101(a)(vi)(C), subject to the Commission's jurisdiction pursuant to Wyo. Stat. § 37-2-112.

On November 3, 2016, EverPower filed its complaint against RMP. On January 30, 2017, EverPower amended its complaint to include Pryor Caves Wind Project LLC; MUD Springs Wind Project LLC; and Horse Thief Wind Project LLC (collectively the Bowler Flats Wind QFs) as joint parties to this matter. The joint complaint alleges EverPower and/or the Bowler Flats Wind QFs have established a legally enforceable obligation with PacifiCorp or RMP at agreed upon rates provided in March 2016 by RMP pursuant to P.S.C. Wyoming No. 16, Schedule 38. Alternatively, the Bowler Flats Wind QFs request that if the Commission determines there is no legally enforceable obligation then the Commission should determine avoided cost pricing and any other unresolved terms of the Power Purchase Agreements (PPAs) between the Bowler Flats Wind QFs and PacifiCorp or RMP.

All interested persons are encouraged to attend the public hearing, which will be conducted in accordance with the Wyoming Administrative Procedure Act and the Wyoming Public Service Commission Rules. Interested persons may appear and be heard, either in person or through counsel, as provided by Commission Rule.

The Commission's hearings are open to all persons.
