

PUBLIC NOTICE

Pursuant to the Wyoming Administrative Procedure Act and the Wyoming Public Service Commission's (Commission) Rules, notice is hereby given that a public hearing is scheduled regarding the Application of Rocky Mountain Power (RMP) for approval of a 3 year Demand Side Management Plan (DSM), the intervention of the Wyoming Industrial Energy Consumers (WIEC), and the intervention of the Wyoming Office of Consumer Advocate (OCA). **The public hearing is set to commence on Tuesday, May 8, 2018, at 9:00 a.m., in the Commission's hearing room located at 2515 Warren Avenue, Suite 300, in Cheyenne, Wyoming.**

RMP is a public utility as defined in Wyo. Stat. § 37-1-101(a)(vi)(C), subject to the Commission's jurisdiction pursuant to Wyo. Stat. § 37-2-112.

On September 28, 2017, RMP filed its Application requesting authority to approve [i] a 3 Year Plan for DSM Acquisition; [ii] the cancelation of Electric Service Schedule Nos. 111, 118, and 140; [iii] modifications to Electric Service Schedule No 191, including adjusting Category 1 and 2 rates to 1.21 percent and 3.58 percent, respectively; and, [iv] a three year planning cycle for DSM targets and budgets, and capitalization and amortization of Category 3 Demand-Side Management expenditures.

RMP states in its Application that it has engaged in a series of communications with members of the WIEC, the OCA, Southwest Energy Efficiency Project (SWEET), the University of Wyoming, Merit Energy, and Commission Staff to discuss the current DSM programs, tariff modification processes, and other concerns with respect to a 3 Year DSM Plan. Those discussions have led to the filing of this Application.

All interested persons are encouraged to attend the public hearing which will be conducted in accordance with the Wyoming Administrative Procedure Act and the Wyoming Public Service Commission Rules. Interested persons may appear and be heard, either in person or through counsel, as provided by Commission Rule.

The Commission's hearings are open to all persons.
