

PUBLIC NOTICE

Pursuant to the Wyoming Administrative Procedure Act and the Wyoming Public Service Commission's (Commission) Rules, notice is hereby given of the Application of Cheyenne Light, Fuel and Power Company d/b/a Black Hills Energy (BHE or the Company), for authority to amend its Rules and Regulations to adjust its Power Cost Adjustment (PCA) application filing deadline from February 15th of each calendar year to May 1st of each calendar year.

BHE is a public utility as defined in Wyo. Stat. § 37-1-101(a)(vi)(C), subject to the Commission's jurisdiction pursuant to Wyo. Stat. § 37-2-112.

On January 9, 2018, BHE filed its Application requesting authority to revise its P.S.C. WYO No. 12, Fourth Revised Sheet No. 44D and Second Revised Sheet No. 53 tariff sheets related to the application filing deadline for the Company's PCA electric rate, established in the tariff as February 15th of each calendar year, for a requested effective date of on and after April 1st of each calendar year. BHE is requesting authority to extend the filing deadline to May 1st of each calendar year, for a requested effective date of on or after June 1st of each calendar year. BHE proposes the filing deadline change to allow more time to compile the required actual and normalized annual earnings information. BHE states the proposed change will extend the PCA collection period approximately sixty (60) days, but customers will not be harmed because the PCA uses a balancing account that tracks all over and/or under collections.

This is not a complete description of the Application. Interested persons may inspect the Application at BHE's Cheyenne, Wyoming, business office and at the Commission's offices located at 2515 Warren Avenue, Suite 300, Cheyenne, Wyoming, during regular business hours. Anyone desiring to file a public comment, statement, intervention petition, protest or request for a public hearing in this matter must file with the Commission in writing on or before July 2, 2018. Any intervention request filed with the Commission shall set forth the grounds of the proposed intervention or request for hearing as well as the position and the interest of the petitioner in this proceeding.
