

PUBLIC NOTICE

Pursuant to the Wyoming Administrative Procedure Act and the Wyoming Public Service Commission's (Commission) Rules, notice is hereby given of the Application of Cheyenne Light, Fuel and Power Company d/b/a Black Hills Energy (BHE or the Company), for an order approving "governmental impositions."

BHE is a public utility as defined in Wyo. Stat. § 37-1-101(a)(vi)(C), subject to the Commission's jurisdiction pursuant to Wyo. Stat. § 37-2-112. BHE is a wholly-owned subsidiary of Black Hills Corporation (BHC).

On April 13, 2018, BHE submitted an Application requesting approval of certain "governmental impositions," which have resulted in recoverable costs to BHE pursuant to its purchases under a Power Purchase Agreement (PPA) between BHE and Black Hills Wyoming, LLC. Specifically, the Company requests approval to seek recovery of the previously incurred and ongoing costs associated with the "governmental impositions" included in the Wygen I PPA, such as those for environmental regulations or taxes. BHE's Tariff requires the Company to receive approval from the Commission before any "governmental impositions" can be included in its delivered power costs. The Company has calculated the revenue requirement to cover these costs as approximately \$713,479.

This is not a complete description of the Application. BHE's Application is on file with the Commission at its offices, located at 2515 Warren Avenue, Suite 300, in Cheyenne, Wyoming, and at the Company's offices located in Cheyenne, Wyoming. Anyone desiring to file a statement, intervention petition, protest or request for a public hearing in this matter must file in writing with the Commission on or before June 11, 2018. A proposed intervention or request for hearing must set forth the grounds under which they are made and the position and interest of the petitioner in this proceeding.
