

PUBLIC NOTICE

Montana-Dakota Utilities Co. (MDU) has received authority from the Wyoming Public Service Commission (Commission) to increase its tax collection rate attributable to the City of Sheridan's Electric Occupation Tax to 0.09%, effective for usage on and after July 1, 2018. The Commission's approval is subject to notice, protest, intervention petition, opportunity for hearing, refund, and such further action as the Commission may deem appropriate.

The average residential customer in Sheridan using 9,555 kWh per year, would see an increase of approximately \$0.11 annually, although the actual increase may vary with usage. MDU's Application is on file with the Commission at its offices in Cheyenne and at MDU's Sheridan offices and may be inspected by any interested person during regular business hours.

This is not a complete description of the Application. Interested persons may inspect the Application at the Commission's offices, located at 2515 Warren Avenue, Suite 300, Cheyenne, Wyoming.
