

PUBLIC NOTICE

The Wyoming Public Service Commission (Commission) hereby gives notice of Black Hills Energy's (BHE or the Company), a division of Cheyenne Light, Fuel and Power Company (CLFP), Application for authority to recover annual Pipeline Safety and Integrity Mechanism (PSIM) costs and revise its tariff to reflect the proposed changes, as more fully described below.

BHE is a public utility as defined by Wyo. Stat. § 37-1-101(a)(vi)(D), subject to the Commission's jurisdiction pursuant to Wyo. Stat. § 37-2-112.

On December 29, 2017, BHE filed its Application, together with testimony and exhibits requesting authority to recover annual Pipeline Safety and Integrity Mechanism (PSIM) costs and revise its tariff to reflect the proposed changes, effective April 1, 2018. In Docket No. 30003-66-GA-15 (PSIM Application docket), the Office of Consumer Advocate and BHE reached a Stipulation and agreed that BHE should be allowed to recover its investment for nine specific projects under the PSIM.

In this Application, BHE is requesting Commission approval of tariff changes to: [i] reflect the PSIM charges; [ii] reflect the PSIM Annual Revenue Requirement; and [iii] reflect the derivation of the PSIM charges.

This is not a complete description of the Application. BHE's Application is on file with the Commission and in BHE's offices in Cheyenne, and may be inspected by any interested person during regular business hours.

Anyone desiring to file a statement, intervention petition, protest or request for a public hearing in this matter must so file, in writing, with the Commission on or before February 9, 2018. The petition shall set forth the grounds of the proposed intervention or request for hearing and the position and interest of the petitioner in this proceeding.
