

## PUBLIC NOTICE

The Wyoming Public Service Commission (Commission) approved the Application of Frannie Deaver Utilities (Frannie Deaver or Company) for authority to revise its Commodity Balancing Account (CBA) tariff and pass on an increase in the total purchased gas cost in the amount of \$0.3922 per Mcf, to be effective for the three-month period of July 1, 2017, through September 30, 2017. The proposed increase is attributable to an increase of \$0.1896 per Mcf in the purchased gas cost and a decrease of \$0.2026 per Mcf in the CBA Amortization credit, based on an over-collected balance of \$12,449 through March 2017. The Commission's approval of Frannie Deaver's Application is subject to notice, protest, intervention, refund, change, further investigation, opportunity for hearing, and further order of the Commission.

The average residential customer using approximately 2.16 Mcf for July 2017 through September 2017 may expect a monthly gas bill increase of approximately \$0.85, or about 3.58%, before taxes. Actual bills will vary with usage.

The proposed retail rate increase will result in a projected dollar-for-dollar increase in the Company's July 1, 2017, through September 30, 2017, revenues of approximately \$1,533.50. The increase does not change the Company's authorized rate of return.

Commission Rule Chapter 3, Section 26 allows a utility to pass on to its customers known or projected commodity cost increases or decreases on a dollar-for-dollar basis, subject to public notice, opportunity for hearing and refund.

Frannie Deaver's Application is on file at the Commission's offices, located at 2515 Warren Avenue, Suite 300, Cheyenne, Wyoming, and at the Company's offices located in Frannie, Wyoming. Anyone desiring to file a statement, intervention petition, protest or request for a public hearing in this matter must file in writing with the Commission on or before September 1, 2017. A proposed intervention or request for hearing must set forth the grounds under which they are made and the position and interest of the petitioner in this proceeding.
