

PUBLIC NOTICE

The Wyoming Public Service Commission (Commission) has given Pinedale Natural Gas, Inc. (PNG or the Company), authority to pass on to its customers through its Commodity Balancing Account (CBA) an decrease in its wholesale natural gas commodity costs of \$0.072 per therm, effective on and after March 28, 2018.

The wholesale gas pass-on decrease is attributable to: [i] a projected wholesale gas cost of \$0.265 per therm, a decrease of \$0.076 per therm; and [ii] a CBA credit of \$0.035 per therm, a decrease in the credit of \$0.004 per therm, to amortize PNG's projected March 31, 2018, over-collected CBA balance of \$69,226, using projected sales of 200,000 Dth.

A typical residential gas customer using 33 therms per month for the rate-effective period of April 2018 through September 2018 may expect a monthly gas bill decrease of \$2.34 or 6.3%, before taxes. Actual bills will vary with usage.

PNG's amended Application is on file at the Commission's offices in Cheyenne, Wyoming, and in the Company's Pinedale, Wyoming, business office and may be inspected by any interested person during regular business hours.

Anyone desiring to file an intervention petition, request for a public hearing, or a statement, public comment or protest in this matter must file in writing with the Commission on or before June 22, 2018. A proposed intervention or request for hearing must set forth the grounds under which they are made and the position and interest of the petitioner in this proceeding.
