

PUBLIC NOTICE

The Wyoming Public Service Commission (Commission) approved the Application of Town of Walden Gas (Walden or Town) to pass on a wholesale gas cost increase of \$0.477 per dekatherm (Dth) to its Residential and Commercial customers, effective on and after May 1, 2018. The Commission's approval of Walden's rate change is subject to notice, protest, intervention, refund, change, further investigation, opportunity for hearing and further order of the Commission.

The average Mountain Home Residential customer, in Wyoming, using approximately 2.2 Dth per month for the period of April 2018 through September 2018, may expect a monthly gas bill increase of approximately \$1.05 or 2.8%, before taxes. The average non-Mountain Home Residential customer, in Wyoming, using approximately 2.7 Dth per month for the period of April 2018 through September 2018, may expect a monthly gas bill increase of approximately \$1.31 or 2.7%, before taxes. Actual monthly gas bills will vary based on usage.

The proposed retail rate increase results in a projected dollar-for-dollar increase in the Town's April 2018 through September 2018 total revenues of approximately \$2,541.00.

Chapter 3, Section 26 of the Commission's Rules allows a utility to pass on to its customers known or projected commodity cost increases or decreases on a dollar-for-dollar basis, subject to public notice, opportunity for hearing, and refund.

Walden's Application is on file at the Commission's offices, located at 2515 Warren Avenue, Suite 300, Cheyenne, Wyoming, and at Walden's Town Hall, located at 513 Harrison Street, Walden, Colorado. Anyone who wants to file an intervention petition, request for a public hearing, or a statement, public comment or protest in this matter must file in writing with the Commission on or before June 8, 2018. A proposed intervention or request for hearing must set forth the grounds under which they are made and the position and interest of the petitioner in this proceeding.
