

PUBLIC NOTICE

The Wyoming Public Service Commission (Commission) has authorized Black Hills Energy (BHE or the Company) to implement a decrease of \$0.0003 per therm in the Company's Revenue Adjustment Mechanism (RAM) rate applicable for all Rate Schedule RCG customers in the Casper Division, effective December 1, 2017, through May 31, 2018, increasing the RAM rate credit from (\$0.0025) per therm to (\$0.0028) per therm. The Commission's approval of BHE's rate change is subject to notice, protest, intervention, refund, change, further investigation, opportunity for hearing and further order of the Commission.

The RAM rate applies to approximately 56,000 Casper Division RCG customers, including Choice Gas customers. The proposed RAM rate will provide for an average monthly decrease of approximately \$0.03 (0.1%) for Casper Division SGS Pass-On Rate [Regulated Rate] Option customers using a monthly average of 106 therms during the rate-effective period of December 1, 2017, through May 31, 2018. Actual bills will vary with usage. The proposed rate decrease results in a projected decrease in the Company's December 2017 through May 2018 revenues of \$18,825.44.

BHE's Application is on file at the Commission's offices, located at 2515 Warren Avenue, Suite 300, Cheyenne, Wyoming, and in the Company's office in Casper, Wyoming. Anyone who wants to file an intervention petition, request for a hearing, or a statement, protest, or public comment in this matter must file in writing with the Commission on or before May 11, 2018. Please mention Docket No. 30022-298-GA-17 (Record No. 14865) when you call or write. Intervention petitions and requests for a hearing must state the position and interest of the person so filing.
