

PUBLIC NOTICE

Pursuant to the Wyoming Administrative Procedure Act and the Wyoming Public Service Commission's (Commission) Procedural Rules and Special Regulations, notice is hereby given of the Application of Pioneer Pipe Line Company (PPLC or Company), for authority to cancel its intrastate transportation tariffs, PPLC Wyoming P.S.C. No. 12.0.

PPLC is engaged in the public utility business of gathering and transporting petroleum products (gasoline, petroleum fuel oil distillate, jet fuel, kerosene, and/or special petroleum products) by pipeline from the Sinclair Station in Carbon County, Wyoming to Little America and Rock Springs in Sweetwater County, Wyoming.

On June 1, 2017, PPLC filed its Application requesting authority to cancel its intrastate transportation tariffs, PPLC Wyoming P.S.C. No. 12.0 (Tariff 12.0), effective July 1, 2017. Tariff 12.0 sets forth the rates for transporting petroleum products (gasoline, petroleum fuel oil distillate, jet fuel, kerosene, and/or special petroleum products) from the Sinclair Station in Carbon County, Wyoming to Little America and Rock Springs in Sweetwater County, Wyoming. Tariff 12.0 also includes the Company's Rules and Regulations associated with Tariff 12.0.

PPLC requests cancellation of Tariff 12.0, because it learned in a recent Commission docket, Docket No. 50012-32-PT-17 (Record No. 14648), that the Commission does not regulate the transportation of refined petroleum products (namely gasoline) by a pipeline. In Docket No. 50012-32-PT-17, the Commission found the tariffs regulating intrastate transportation did not serve a useful purpose, because "the transportation of refined petroleum products (namely gasoline) by a pipeline is not an activity within the scope of Wyo. Stat. § 37-1-101(a)(vi)(G)." PPLC states if the Commission approves its' Application it will continue to ship gasoline as a product, but that gasoline will be shipped via a federal FERC tariff or a PPLC rate sheet.

This is not a complete description of PPLC's Application. Interested persons may inspect the Application at PPLC's business office and at the Commission's offices in Cheyenne, Wyoming, during regular business hours, or online at <http://psc.state.wy.us/>.

Anyone desiring to file a public comment, statement, intervention petition, protest or request for a public hearing in this matter must do file with the Commission in writing on or before September 8, 2017. Any intervention request filed with the Commission shall set forth the grounds of the proposed intervention or request for hearing, as well as the position and the interest of the petitioner in this proceeding.
