

PUBLIC NOTICE

Pursuant to the Wyoming Administrative Procedure Act and the Wyoming Public Service Commission's (Commission) Rules, notice is hereby given that a public hearing has been scheduled regarding the Application of Rocky Mountain Pipeline System, LLC (RMPS or the Company) for authority to cancel its W.P.S.C. Tariff Nos. 3 and 8, rates used in transport., and upon the intervention of Merit Energy Company (Merit). **The public hearing is set to commence on Wednesday, August 23, 2017, at 9:00 a.m., in the Commission's hearing room located at 2515 Warren Avenue, Suite 300, in Cheyenne, Wyoming.**

RMPS is a public utility as defined in Wyo. Stat. § 37-1-101(a)(vi)(G), subject to the Commission's jurisdiction pursuant to Wyo. Stat. § 37-2-112.

On January 23, 2017, RMPS submitted its Application requesting the Commission cancel its W.P.S.C. Nos 3 and 8. Regarding its request to cancel W.P.S.C. Tariff No. 3, RMPS states that there have not been any shipments of crude petroleum product under this tariff for years. According to RMPS, all shipments of crude petroleum product from the Company's Hamilton Dome Station have been interstate in nature and shipped on the applicable Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) tariff: Tariff Nos. 187.11.0 and 189.12.0. RMPS represents qualified requests for the interstate transportation of crude petroleum are transported under the correct FERC tariff. Regarding W.P.S.C. No. 8 tariff and applicable supplements, RMPS states that this tariff contains provisions for the gathering of products at Hamilton Dome from RMPS to another line, and for gathering service at Sand Draw. RMPS states the ownership of the gathering facilities at Hamilton Dome has been transferred and the referenced gathering services at Sand Draw is no longer operative. Therefore, the gathering services are no longer provided by RMPS and the tariff should be cancelled. RMPS asserts that the cancellation of its W.P.S.C Nos. 3 and 8 tariffs will have no adverse effect on the public interest.

All interested persons are encouraged to attend the public hearing which will be conducted in accordance with the Wyoming Administrative Procedure Act and the Wyoming Public Service Commission Rules and Special Regulations. Interested persons may appear and be heard, either in person or through counsel, as provided by Commission Rule.
