

PUBLIC NOTICE

Pursuant to the Wyoming Administrative Procedure Act and the Wyoming Public Service Commission's (Commission) Rules, the Commission hereby gives notice of the joint application of Rocky Mountain Pipeline System LLC (RMPS) and Tesoro Logistics Northwest Pipeline, LLC (Tesoro) (collectively the Parties), for approval of the transfer and sale of certain pipeline assets (Facilities) to Tesoro.

RMPS is a public utility as defined in Wyo. Stat. § 37-1-101(a)(vi)(G), subject to the Commission's jurisdiction under Wyo. Stat. § 37-2-112. RMPS is a Texas limited liability company authorized to do business operating an intrastate crude oil pipeline in Wyoming with its principle business office located in Houston, Texas.

Tesoro is a Delaware limited liability company with offices located in San Antonio, Texas. Tesoro, if granted certificate authority, would become a public utility, natural gas common carrier, as defined in Wyo. Stat. § 37-1-101(a)(vi)(G), subject to the Commission's jurisdiction pursuant to the provisions of Wyo. Stat. § 37-2-112. Tesoro is a wholly-owned subsidiary of Andeavor Logistic LP (Andeavor). Andeavor is one of the largest full-service providers of midstream logistics in the Western United States. Andeavor owns and operates extensive pipeline, refinery, processing, and other facilities and systems.

The Parties filed their Application with the Commission on March 27, 2018, pursuant to Wyo. Stat. § 37-1-104 and Commission Rule Chapter 3, Section 21, requesting Commission approval of the transfer and sale of certain RMPS Facilities to Tesoro. In addition, Tesoro is requesting the Commission issue it a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (CPCN).

Tesoro states that it has the financial ability and good faith, and that the community has the necessity, for the continued operation of the Carter Creek Line. The Parties state that Andeavor, Tesoro's parent company, is capable of operating the Facility.

RMPS's Facilities at issue in this Application, is an intrastate sour condensate (crude petroleum) transportation pipeline in Wyoming, running from Carter Creek to the Silver Eagle Refinery, all located in Uinta County, Wyoming. The Carter Creek Line is an eight-inch diameter pipe running approximately 27 miles from Carter Creek to the Silver Eagle Refinery.

The Parties represent the transfer and sale will not result in a functional change to the operation of the Facility's crude oil transportation services in Wyoming. The Parties further state approval of the Application will have no adverse impact on the public or other Wyoming utilities.

The Commission has specific authority over this proposed transaction pursuant to the provisions of Wyo. Stat. § 37-1-104, which provides that the Commission may approve a proposed reorganization, which is defined as any transaction which results in the change of ownership of a majority of the voting stock of a public utility, or a change in the ownership or control of any entity which owns or controls a majority of the voting capital stock of a public utility, unless, after public notice and opportunity for hearing it determines that the reorganization will adversely affect the utility's ability to serve the public.

The Application is on file with the Commission at its offices in Cheyenne, Wyoming, and may be inspected there by any interested person during regular business hours.

Anyone desiring to intervene and become a party to this proceeding or to file a statement, comment, protest, or request a hearing in this matter, must file the same with the Commission in writing on or before April 27, 2018. Any petitions for intervention or hearing shall set forth the grounds of the proposed intervention or request for hearing and the position and interest of the petitioner.
