

PUBLIC NOTICE

Pursuant to the Wyoming Administrative Procedure Act and the Wyoming Public Service Commission's (Commission) Rules, notice is hereby given of the Application of Range Telephone Cooperative, Inc. ("Range" or the "Company"), for authority to amend its Rules and Regulations for compliance with the Commission's revised Rules, effective March 21, 2016.

Range is a telecommunications company as defined by Wyo. Stat. § 37-15-103(a)(xi), and as such is subject to the Commission's jurisdiction pursuant to Wyo. Stat. § 37-15-401.

On September 29, 2016, Range filed its Application requesting authority to revise its Rules and Regulations for conformance with the Commission's revised Rules, effective March 21, 2016. Proposed revisions include changes to the tariff symbol language (Sheet 3-1); removal of one TAP reference that inadvertently remained when TAP was otherwise removed from the tariff (Sheet 1-4); replacement of the deposit language with the applicable language from the WYPS Rules (Sheets 3-7 and 3-8); and, replacement of the discontinuance notice language with the applicable language from the WYPSC Rules (Sheets 3-9, 3-9.1 and 3-10).

This is not a complete description of the Application. Interested persons may inspect the Application at the Commission's offices in Cheyenne, Wyoming, during regular business hours.

Anyone desiring to file a public comment, statement, intervention petition, protest or request for a public hearing in this matter must do so by filing with the Commission in writing on or before September 7, 2018. Any intervention request filed with the Commission shall set forth the grounds of the proposed intervention or request for hearing as well as the position and the interest of the petitioner in this proceeding.
