

PUBLIC NOTICE

Pursuant to the Wyoming Administrative Procedure Act and the Wyoming Public Service Commission's (Commission) Rules, notice is hereby given of the Application of CenturyTel of Wyoming, Inc., d/b/a CenturyLink ("CenturyLink" or the "Company"), for authority to amend its Rules and Regulations for compliance with the Commission's revised Rules, effective March 21, 2016.

CenturyLink is a telecommunications company as defined by Wyo. Stat. § 37-15-103(a)(xi), and as such is subject to the Commission's jurisdiction pursuant to Wyo. Stat. § 37-15-401.

On September 30, 2016, CenturyLink filed its Application requesting authority to revise its Rules and Regulations for conformance with the Commission's revised Rules, effective March 21, 2016. CenturyLink is proposing amendments to WCWR 023-000-0004 and WCWR 023-000-0005 to implement and update the Company's Price Schedule 1. CenturyLink states the proposed revisions to Price Schedule No 1 will not change the services provided nor the rates customers are charged for such services. The proposed changes include, but are not limited to removal of references to Maps; the addition of new URLs to allow users to access Exchange Maps; and changes to symbols to conform with the Joint Waiver of the Rule; updates to language for clarification and consistency. Proposed revisions may also include amendments to its tariffs governing the schedule of fees, discontinuation of service, reconnection of service, customer deposits, and customer service. These provisions will affect customers in the Big Piney, Farson, Medicine Bow, Pinedale, Boulder, and Daniel Exchanges.

This is not a complete description of the Application. Interested persons may inspect the Application at the Commission's offices in Cheyenne, Wyoming, during regular business hours.

Anyone desiring to file a public comment, statement, intervention petition, protest or request for a public hearing in this matter must do so by filing with the Commission in writing on or before May 21, 2018. Any intervention request filed with the Commission shall set forth the grounds of the proposed intervention or request for hearing as well as the position and the interest of the petitioner in this proceeding.
