

PUBLIC NOTICE

United Telephone Company of the West d/b/a CenturyLink of the West (United or the Company) received authority from the Wyoming Public Service Commission (Commission) to revise its late payment penalty from an interest factor of 0.000493 to 0.000407 per day, which represents a decrease of approximately 3.09% per annum. The proposed change is to standardize the penalty amount for all three CenturyLink companies: Qwest Corporation (Qwest), United Telephone Company of the West, and CenturyTel of Wyoming, Inc. This approval is effective on and after April 1, 2017, subject to public notice, protest, intervention, investigation, opportunity for hearing, and such further modification and order by the Commission.
