

PUBLIC NOTICE

The Wyoming Public Service Commission (Commission) has authorized Red Lane Domestic Water, Inc., (Red Lane or Company) to pass on to its customers an increase of \$0.22 per 1,000 gallons and an increase of \$18.00 per meter, on an interim basis, effective immediately. This approval is subject to notice, protest, investigation, opportunity for hearing, change, refund, and such other orders as the Commission may deem appropriate.

A typical Wyoming customer using an average 10,000 gallons per month may expect an average monthly increase of \$20.20 or 18.57%. Actual bills will vary with usage.

Pursuant to Commission Rules, a utility may apply to pass on to its customers known or prospective wholesale commodity cost increases or decreases on a dollar-for-dollar basis and subject to public notice, opportunity for hearing, and refund.

The Application is on file at the Commission's offices in Cheyenne, Wyoming, and at Red Lane's business office in, Thermopolis, Wyoming, and may be inspected by any interested person during regular business hours.

Anyone desiring to file a request for a public hearing, intervention petition, statement, protest, or public comment in this matter must file in writing with the Commission on or before August 31, 2017. The petition shall set forth the grounds of the proposed intervention or request for hearing, and the position and interest of the petitioner in this proceeding.
