

PUBLIC NOTICE

Pursuant to the Wyoming Administrative Procedure Act and the Wyoming Public Service Commission's (Commission) Rules, notice is hereby given of the Application of Lake Water Company, LLC (Lake Water or Company) for authority to amend its Rules and Regulations for compliance with the Commission's revised Rules, effective March 21, 2016.

Lake Water is a public utility as defined in Wyo. Stat. § 37-1-101(a)(vi)(E), subject to the Commission's jurisdiction pursuant to Wyo. Stat. § 37-2-112.

On April 11, 2017, Lake Water filed its Application requesting authority to revise its Rules and Regulations for conformance with the Commission's revised Rules, effective March 21, 2016, pursuant to Commission Rule Chapter 3, Section 25. Lake Water states that it revised the wording and format of its General Rules and Regulations for Water Service, Tariff #4. Specifically, Lake Water revised the Inspection and Billing section of its tariff and amended the date bills are sent annually from February 1st to January 1st. Additionally, Lake Water added to its tariff a section entitled Backflow and Cross-Connection Protection setting forth rules and regulations to protect the water utility's water supply against actual or potential contamination through cross-connections and to prevent future cross-connections. Lastly, Lake Water added a definition section to its proposed tariff.

This is not a complete description of the Application. Interested persons may inspect the Application at Lake Water's business office in Glendo, Wyoming and at the Commission's offices in Cheyenne, Wyoming, during regular business hours, or on the Commission's website at: <http://psc.state.wy.us/>.

Anyone desiring to file a public comment, statement, intervention petition, protest or request for a public hearing in this matter must do file with the Commission in writing on or before May 25, 2017. Any intervention request filed with the Commission shall set forth the grounds of the proposed intervention or request for hearing as well as the position and the interest of the petitioner in this proceeding.
