

PUBLIC NOTICE

The Wyoming Public Service Commission (Commission) hereby gives notice that Lake Water Company, LLC (Lake Water or the Company) has submitted an Application for authority to increase its rates by \$20,160.00 per year, or \$180.00 per customer per year, as more fully described below.

On September 26, 2018, Lake Water Company, LLC (Lake Water) filed an Application requesting authority to increase its water rates resulting in an annual revenue increase for the Company of \$20,160.00 per year. The requested increase translates into an increase of \$180.00 per year per Lake Water customer, from \$600.00 per year to \$780.00 per year, or approximately 30%.

Lake Water explains the increase will enable the Company to begin repairs/replacement on three different water lines at a total estimated cost of \$68,000.00, and that the repairs would take place as funds become available. Lake Water further states it would like to hire a tank cleaning company and purchase a 10-15 HP reserve pump. The repairs and purchases would occur over a five-year period. Lastly, Lake Water states the revenue increase would allow the Company to pay its manager an annual wage of \$20,400.00, which has not occurred since 2014.

This is not a complete description of Lake Water's Application. Interested persons may inspect the Application at the Commission's offices in Cheyenne, during regular business hours or by visiting the Commission's web site at: <http://psc.state.wy.us/>.

Anyone desiring to file a public comment, statement, intervention petition, protest or request for a public hearing in this matter must so file with the Commission in writing on or before November 5, 2018. Any intervention request filed with the Commission shall set forth the grounds of the proposed intervention or request for hearing as well as the position and the interest of the petitioner in this proceeding.
