

PUBLIC NOTICE

Pursuant to the Wyoming Administrative Procedure Act, W.S. § 37-1-101, *et seq.*, and the Wyoming Public Service Commission's (Commission) Rules, notice is hereby given that a hearing regarding the funding requirement and proposed assessment factor for the July 2018 to June 2019 fiscal year of the Wyoming Universal Service Fund (WUSF), is scheduled to commence **Friday, May 4, 2018, at 9:00 a.m. in the Commission's hearing room located at 2515 Warren Avenue, Suite 300, Cheyenne, Wyoming.** It is anticipated that deliberations will be conducted immediately following the hearing. In addition to the assessment factor, the Commission will establish the WUSF distributions to be made to each qualifying telecommunications company pursuant to W.S. § 37-15-501. These items will be established on an interim basis, pending conclusion of a protest period.

On April 13, 2018, the WUSF Manager filed her Manager's Report under Commission Rule Chapters, Section 3(b). The Report presents calculations for distributions pursuant to W.S. § 37-15-501(d) utilizing the \$30 imputed price benchmark outlined in W.S. § 37-15-501(h). The Report also presents calculations for distributions pursuant to W.S. § 37-15-501(g).

Due to the interest in this docket, the Commission has determined it will hold a hearing. The following procedural schedule has been set:

Anyone desiring to file a statement, comments or protest in this matter must so file, in writing, with the Commission by 4:00 p.m. on Wednesday, May 2, 2018. The hearing will be conducted in accordance with the Wyoming Administrative Procedure Act and the Commission's Rules. All interested persons may appear and be heard, either in person or through counsel, as provided by Commission rule.
