2. The Commission hereby gives public notice of its intent to revise Commission Rules Chapters 4 and 5. Revisions are necessary to both Chapters to provide further clarity issues regarding the confidentiality of company information filed with the Wyoming Universal Service Fund annual reports and resulting disbursement amounts. The Commission is also proposing to implement changes to clarify definitions that apply to telecommunications and remove Eligible Telecommunications Carrier language discussing five year plans that are no longer necessary to the Annual Certification Guidelines and Standards set forth in Part 54 of Title 47 of CFR. The proposed changes also include a revision to price schedule symbols and reference marks to be consistent with industry standards used by the National Exchange Carrier Association.
