

PUBLIC NOTICE

The Wyoming Public Service Commission will hold a public technical conference for all interested parties to engage in a discussion of:

1. The potential involvement of Wyoming electric utilities in regional electric markets.

This topic is expected to include discussion of best practices pertaining to the development of regional electric markets, lessons from other states' experiences, potential costs and benefits for ratepayers of Wyoming utilities' involvement in regional markets, and related matters.

2. Retail electric customer choice in the U.S.

This topic is expected to include discussion of the experiences of other states where electricity generation and other aspects of electric service have been made subject to retail customer choice, best practices pertaining to implementing retail customer choice, potential effects on customer rates, and related matters.
